ATLANTIC COAST OBSERVER NETWORK, MD / DE / DC CHAPTER WITH DATA FROM NEARBY AREAS

ONE MAJOR PRECIPITATION EVENT

The following was taken from the **Jeff Stoudt's** report which sums up April's temperatures: "Temperatures this April till the 21st were frequently warmer than normal, though not as consistently so as March, with the apex on the 16th when the year's first 90 temperature occurred. Temperatures then tanked after the 21st, offsetting much of the temperature excess accrued the first 21 days".

Precipitation this month was below normal. Without the storm around the 22nd the monthly totals at many stations would have been less than an inch. Measurable snow was reported at three Maryland ACON stations, **Frostburg**, **LaVale**, and **Smithsburg 3 NE** in addition to the West Virginia mountain station **Davis 3 SE**.

According to NCDC the first four months of 2012 have been the warmest and driest for both **Maryland** and **Delaware** in 118 years of records.


Temperatures this month were much closer to normal than last month. The following observers reported their average temperature cooler than March: **Marty Brumback** of **Bryans Road 2 ESE**, **Ron Berger** of **Norbeck 1 SE**, **Richard Holden** of **Clarksburg 2 ENE**, **Kevin Shaw** of **Gaithersburg 2 WNW**, **Max Hutto** of **Smithsburg 1.5 SW**, and **Dave Lesher** of **Davis 3 SE WV**. **Tony Scafide** of **Bethesda** tied March's average temperature. NWS Washington Dulles also had an average temperature less than March.

The first 20 days were quite dry extending the dry period which began early in March. The lack of rains during this period permitted the ground to become much drier than normal. Instability showers on the 11th brought precipitation in various forms: rain, snow, sleet, hail, and graupel across the region. Liquid amounts were only a few hundreds of an inch. Additional light rains fell on the 15th, 18th, and 19th.

The heaviest rains since Leap Day (February 29th) fell on the 22nd and 23rd. Over two inches fell east of the

Chesapeake Bay. Wet snow fell in the mountains of extreme Maryland and West Virginia. Showers and thunderstorms which preceded the 22nd - 23rd event on the 21st brought upwards to an inch plus in portions of Washington County Maryland. Freezing to near freezing temperatures were scattered throughout the first half of the month - on the 3rd, 7th, 8th, 11th and near months end on the 28th. The last period of 30's occurred from the 23rd to the 30th in the northern regions.

The warmest temperatures occurred mid month and on the 21st when 80 degrees readings were common. A few 90's occurred on the 15th south of Baltimore and in **LaVale**.

OBSERVER COMMENTS FOR APRIL 2012

Gary Gallaher of Bear 2 SW, DE

Dry month with seasonal temperatures. Yards began to brown due to lack of moisture by mid month. Less than an inch of rain fell from 3/2/12 to 4/21/12 (51 days, 0.99"), very unusual for this time of the year.

22nd - 2.02" of rain, the third greatest April daily total in 44 years of April records.

28th - Record minimum temperature. Old was 32° in 2010.

23rd - 2" snow depth - Only day with measureable snow on the ground at observation time.

Nate Mullins of LaVale

April was a very quiet weather month with near normal temps and well below normal precip, the 3rd driest April on record.

16th - 90° record maximum temp, old was 88° in 2002.

23rd - 43° record low maximum temp, old was 46° in 1984. Rain with some wet snow mixed in. Snow accumulated to several inches on Piney mountain, just to our west.

22nd - Rainy with daytime temperature in the 40's.

11th - Cloudy, cool, light rain in early PM, windy.

16th - Partly cloudy, low humidity, hot.

11th - Showers of rain, snow, and graupel.

23rd - Rain, wet snowflakes early, flakes & sleet PM, cold.

20th - Fog early, sunny and warmer.

Second driest April behind 1.90" in 1997. Monthly PWG of 37 mph occurred on three days: 9th (W), 11th & 27th (WNW).

7th - Humidity quite low.

11th - Few drops and graupel 12:30PM, sprinkle / graupel 1:20-1:30PM.

Kevin Shaw of Gaithersburg 2 WNW

Third driest April. April's average temperature was 0.4° above normal but 0.2° cooler than March. 2012 along with 2010 are the only Aprils when the temps failed to fall to freezing. Some snow and graupel fell on the 11th in parts of Montgomery County but none was observed here.

23rd - Record minimum maximum temperature of 46°.

28th - Record minimum maximum temperature of 53°.

Temperatures averaged close to normal. The average minimum temperature was 0.7° colder than March's.

3rd - Relative humidity fell into the low teens.

22nd - Dramatic temperature change: low 80's yesterday, mid 40's this afternoon.

27th - Windy very early coupled with the now fully developed tree canopies caused a 35 minute power outage 0140-0215 hours.

23rd - SHRA 0000 intermittently through 1900. Reports of sleet in area 1630-1700 but none observed here.

15 days straight w/o measureable rain (Apr 3 to 17)

22nd - Most rain in a calendar day (2.51") since Aug 27, 2011 (during Hurricane Irene).

29th - Strong thunderstorm from 12:25 - 2:55 AM (1.02")

3rd - Cold AM, 29°, warm PM, 72°.

11th - Cold AM with heavy frost.

21st - Rain starting mid afternoon with distant thunder.
